Camp Information and Rules

The following guidelines for conduct and camp safety are in the best interest of campers:

1. All campers are expected to abide by the rules of the camp, which are explained at orientation
2. The camps are closed to VISITORS except when an invitation has been extended by the Camp Director
3. Cars are off limits to campers during the week of camp. Keys will be surrendered at registration and returned at the close of camp
4. No electronic devices, noisemakers, fireworks, weapons, or drugs are allowed. Prescription medication is to be administered by the camp nurse only
5. Camp dress code: modest dress is expected of young men and women (no bare midriffs, no spaghetti strap tops, and no short shorts). When swimming is included in camp activity, young men are not permitted to wear competition or bikini trunks, and young women are allowed to wear modest, tankini or one-piece bathing suits
6. A violation of camp rules may result in being sent home *at parents expense*
7. All damages incurred by campers will be billed to a parent and that camper will not be allowed to attend camp again until damages are paid.
8. Mild pranks will be tolerated. Mild pranks do not invade someone's privacy, does not harm or destroy a person's possessions, does not include girls in guy's rooms or guys in girl's rooms, and does not deface their being. If pranks are pulled outside these guidelines there will be consequences.
