

Cornerstone: Destination Syracuse 2006 Student Expectations & Guidelines

I will adhere and abide by the following expectations and guidelines:

- I will have a positive and Christ-like attitude.
- I will not complain excessively.
- I will be kind and courteous to everyone at all times.
- I will respect and obey ALL Youth Sponsors at ALL times.
- I understand that I am not to name call, put down, or belittle anyone on my team.
- I will not bring cigarettes, illegal drugs, alcohol, weapons, fire arms, or fire work paraphernalia.
- I understand that there are no showers available and will need to take a “sink bath” in the morning.
- I will not leave the property of Christ Community Church: A Church of the Nazarene with anyone from August 4-5 but Pastor Meggan and the Refuge Youth Staff.
- I will not use my cell phone other than to call home, or for emergency purposes. I will not make social calls to my friends while on the Cornerstone trip. I understand that my cell phone can be confiscated if I abuse this rite.
- I will dress modestly at all times. For females: spaghetti strap tank tops, tube tops, scoop neck shirts, halter tops, belly baring shirts (and any other shirt/tank top of this nature), and short shorts are not permitted. For guys: muscle shirts, “wife beater” tank tops, pants that expose underwear, and going shirtless are not permitted.
- I have read “What To and Not To Bring,” and I understand what I am supposed to bring, and what I am not supposed to bring.
- I will adhere to the “buddy system.” Meaning, I will choose a buddy and stick by my buddy at all times. I understand that the buddy I choose on August 4th is to remain my buddy until August 5th when we return. I understand that this is for my safety.
- When on the work sites I will not loiter or disappear, but will be helpful and conscientious about working at each designated place.
- During lights out no one is permitted outside their assigned room for any reason (well, ok if it’s life threatening, like a fire or something! But that’s it!!!)
- Guys are not allowed in girls sleeping quarters, and girls are not allowed in guys sleeping quarters.
- Mild pranks will be tolerated. Mild pranks do not invade someone’s privacy, does not harm or destroy a person’s possessions, does not include girls in guy’s rooms or guys in girl’s rooms, and does not deface their being. If pranks are pulled outside these guidelines there will be consequences.
